POLICY 8305 - INFORMATION SECURITY

This new policy includes the following key points:

1. There is a reference to the definitions in Bylaw 0100 for technology resources and information resources when these terms are first mentioned in the policy.

The reference to Bylaw 0100 will be a link so that the reader can toggle to the bylaw and read the definitions if s/he desires to do so.

- 2. In the second paragraph the Board determines the 3 classifications of data/information.
- 3. The policy requires all individuals who may be granted access to information resources to certify annually that they will comply with the established security protocols.
- 4. The Superintendent shall set forth the internal controls necessary to provide for the collection, classification, retention, access, and security of District data/information.
- 5. The Superintendent is charged with developing procedures to be followed if there is an unauthorized release or a breach of the information/data collected and retained by the District.
- 6. The policy requires disciplinary consequences if an employee, student, or vendor/contractor does not adhere to the requirements of the policy.
