


Distribution of Overall VAM Ratings for Teachers




### Distribution of Overall VAM Ratings for Teachers




### Ratio of Classroom Expenditures to Total Expenditures







## Per-Pupil Expenditures 0

Florida's per-pupil expenditures are calculated as the current expenditures divided by unweighted full-time equivalent students using guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Education. Current expenditures are comprised of expenditures for the day-to-day operation of schools and local educational agencies (LEAs), including but not limited to, expenditures for instruction, administration, instructional support, and operation and maintenance of plant. Expenditures are disaggregated by fund source (state and local or federal) and by type of cost (school-level or district-level).


